- researching and examining every contribution received by the editorial board.

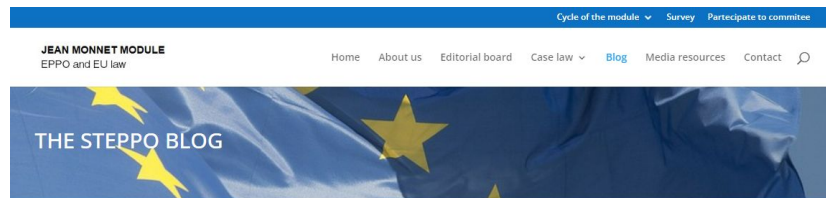

CRIMINAL LAWYER: FABRIZIO DE' SANNA

- First of all, I have to say that I am really glad of the results achieved during this year, and we are all confident that next year will be even greater. There are many issues that can be developed and we are willing to do it. Wanting to summarize the main topics dealt with together, we have:
- **Eppo's Annual Report 2021**: which highlighted that the countries with the highest number of open inquiries are Italy (102), Bulgaria (98) and Germany (54).
- **Procedural guarantees**. Among these, by analyzing the discipline of wire tapes in the Italian, French and Spanish legal systems we outline that the Italian one is the most guaranteeing.
- Finally, we also held a class about the **digitalization**: in particular about the objective, pursued at EU level, of modernize and make more efficient EU cross-border procedures, adopting the “digital by default” principle.

CIVIL LAWYER: FEDERICO IACOPO MAMOLI

- Civil law lawyers participated very actively in Steppo conferences during the second part of Steppo Programme. They asked a lot of questions to Steppo lecturers particularly in the area of the consequences of seizure of accounts and assets ordered by European Public Prosecutor's office.
- I've had the chance, in quality of head of Steppo civil lawyers committee and member of AIGA, to take part of the lawyers delegation of "AIGA mission" at some European Institutions in Luxembourg like European Court of Justice, Court of Auditors and European Commission (Eurostat office) from 29 to 31 March 2023.
- The stay at the European Court of Justice was productive in terms of assisting at a hearing, learning of how it works in practice and networking opportunities. I had the opportunity to explain the activity of Steppo to members of all the institutions exploring ways of cooperation with them in the next future.
- I finally started to set the basis for the visit of Steppo attendees to EPPO offices in the second part of year 2023.

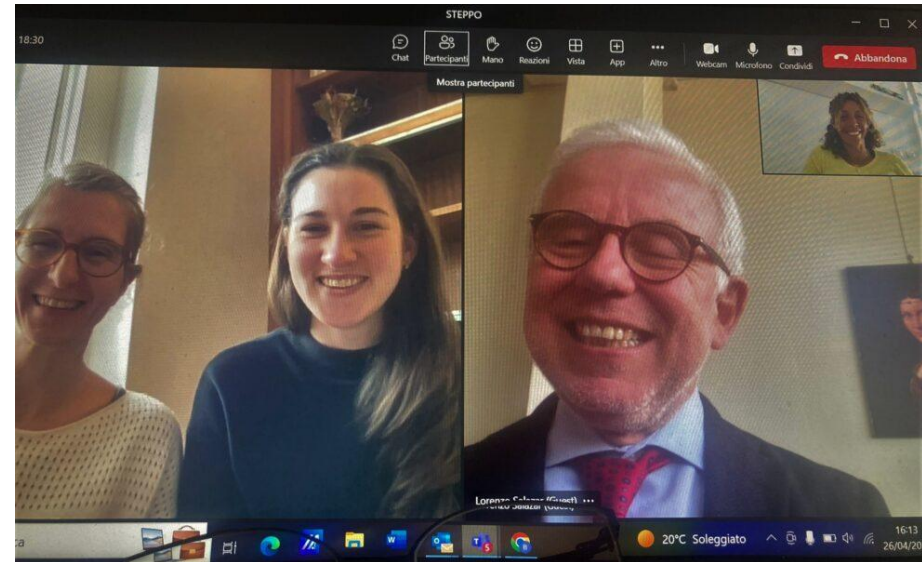

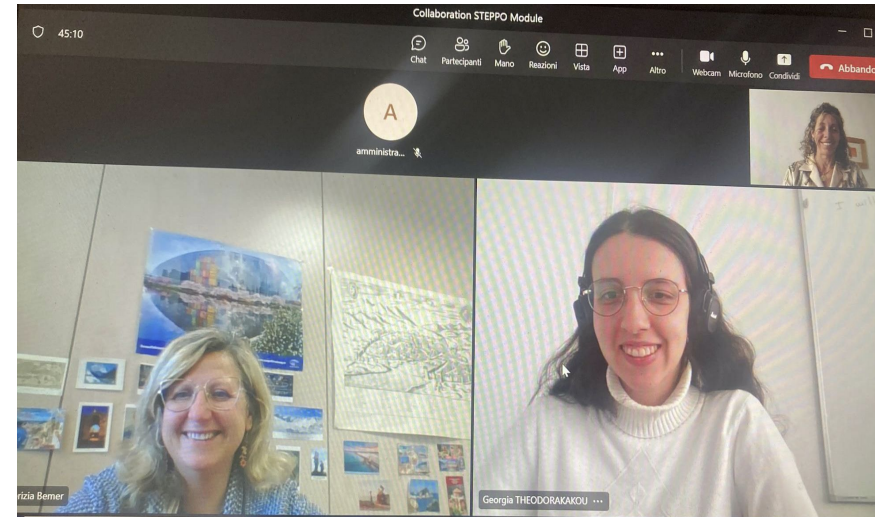
NEW COLLABORATION WITH THE UNIVERSITÉ LIBRE DE BRUXELLES (ULB)

- 26 April 2023 an electronic bridge was set up between Milan and Brussels. The Module was represented by Benedetta Ubertazzi alongside Lorenzo Salazar, while the ULB was represented by Chloé Brière (Professor in European Law) and Laura Schmeer (Research Fellow).
- We are delighted to offer access to the article “**The establishment of the European Public Prosecutor’s Office: Integration with limited supranationalisation?**” published by Laura Schmeer (Research Fellow, ULB) in the Journal of European Integration. Lorenzo Salazar made his contribution by participating in an interview specially arranged for drafting the article.
- We also invite you to participate in the **Summer School on the EU Area of Criminal Justice**, which will take place on 3-7 July 2023 in Brussels. Organised by the Institute for European Studies of the ULB and the European Criminal Law Academic Network (ECLAN).



NEW COLLABORATION WITH THE UNIVERSITÉ DU LUXEMBOURG

- 4 May 2023, Another virtual bridge was set up: this time between Milan and Luxembourg, thanks to Fabrizia Bemer, Lorenzo Salazar, Prof. Dr. Katalin Ligeti (professor of European and international criminal law at Uni.Lu), and Georgia Theodorakakou (Doctoral Researcher in European Criminal Law at Uni.Lu).
- The Uni.lu has invited Fabrizia Bemer and Veronica Carbone to promote a pilot project on EPPO during the upcoming Conference “EPPO the way forward: new potentials and challenges” (5-6 June 2023, Luxembourg).
- The pilot project is the first **VR Game on EPPO**, coined by Fabrizia Bemer with five law students and projected with the amazing work of the the Mind and Behavior Technological Centre (MiBTec). The game is a Serious Game, that simulates the preliminary investigations phase in a criminal case under the competence of the EPPO.

PREVIOUS SUCCESS

- - The serious game has been launched during the presentation of the II cycle of Jean Monnet Module on 27.02.2023.
- The students have played the scenes, which have been shot with a 360° video camera to make it real and useable for the virtual reality
- Within the PNRR of the University Bicocca and in the framework of a project on legality The Liceo Breda of Milan has asked for lessons on EPPO and 200 students will experiment the VR.
- They will be submitted a questionnaire whose results will be shown during the final lesson of the II cycle.

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES FOR MAY-JUNE

- After the Conference, **which has been a real success** , new articles have been posted
- Beginning of May Prof. Benedetta Ubertazzi and I have been contacted by the **University of Luxembourg – Department of Law**, because they are interested in the Steppo Project and we have been invited to speak at the Conference, which will be in June 5^o and 6ht, title of the conference: **EPPO THE WAY FORWARD: NEW POTENTIALS AND CHALLENGES**. INTERVIEW TO THE EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTOR IN MILAN, DOTT. GAETANO RUTA.

Key concepts:



EPPO is working with Italian Guardia di Finanza and dealing with VAT frauds, especially in Northern Italy and in Milan.



EPPO's relationship with banking institutions: preventive seizures of bank accounts are often ordered while preventive measures and judicial administrations are not usually executed.



Relations with Supervisory Authorities (Bank of Italy and BCE) have not changed compared to the past, involving a great cooperation in fighting money laundering.



Future prospects: an attempt is underway to harmonize relations with Banking Institutions in order to facilitate cross-border communication by making banking documentation more uniform.

INTERVIEW TO THE EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTOR IN MILAN, DOTT. GAETANO RUTA

Quali sono le prospettive de iure condendo per EPPO? Non si sta ancora parlando di una giurisdizione europea né di una “procedura penale europea”, ma ci sono dei tentativi progressivi di armonizzazione, soprattutto con riferimento all’uniformità ed intelligibilità della documentazione, anche bancaria.



Che rapporti avete con le Autorità di Vigilanza e le istituzioni nella lotta al riciclaggio?

Abbiamo principalmente rapporti con **Banca d'Italia**, in relazione al comparto bancario e alla segnalazione di operazioni sospette, e anche con la **BCE**, con cui è previsto un incontro ad aprile per noi procuratori a Francoforte per avere un’interlocuzione diretta sulle modalità lavorative. In ottica di cooperazione con queste istituzioni sono stati firmati dagli organi centrali di EPPO alcuni **protocolli di intesa** (come ad es. quelli stipulati con UIF e EIB) che sono molto utili a livello di cooperazione sia dal punto di vista della vigilanza, sia in materia di riciclaggio.

Di cosa si occupa EPPO a Milano? Siamo 3 magistrati dotati di competenza unica nazionale in materia di reati che ledono gli interessi finanziari dell’UE. Ci occupiamo prevalentemente di frodi in materia IVA in Lombardia e di qualche reato contro la PA, mentre nel Sud Italia si occupano maggiormente di frodi legate a contributi per l’agricoltura e per lo sviluppo imprenditoriale.

Disponete misure di prevenzione, amministrazioni giudiziarie o sequestri? Che rapporti avete con gli Istituti di credito?

Allo stato non disponiamo misure di prevenzione, né amministrazioni giudiziarie. Disponiamo invece molti sequestri secondo i modelli tradizionali del cpp (sequestro preventivo, per equivalente e per sproporzione). Quando sequestriamo conti correnti bancari se ne dà comunicazione all’Istituto di credito, le somme vengono devolute al Fondo Unico Giustizia, poi interviene la confisca e le somme entrano nella disponibilità dello Stato.
